Course Description: An immersive, fast-paced, hands-on simulation workshop for emergency medicine residents to practice:

- Delivering a normal, spontaneous vaginal delivery
- Applying techniques for birthing complications:
 - Shoulder dystocia
 - Breech delivery
- Recognizing and treating hypertensive emergencies:
 - Chronic hypertension
 - Gestational hypertension
 - Pre-eclampsia
 - Eclampsia
 - HELLP syndrome
- Applying techniques to treat post-partum hemorrhage from:
 - Uterine atony
 - Cervical/vaginal lacerations
 - Retained placenta
 - Vulvar hematoma
- Managing maternal resuscitation from trauma, performing peri-mortem c-section
- Managing post-gyn surgical complications
 - Wound separation, wound dehiscence
 - Vaginal cuff dehiscence
 - Post conization bleeding
- Providing emergency medical care for victims of sex trafficking
- Applying techniques for neonatal evaluation and resuscitation
