SCS & Spartan Medical Research Journal (SMRJ) Formatting checklist

We will not be able to copy edit your paper or review your SMRJ submission until you adhere to each of the following:

1. Place your copy editing request with your contact information at:
<https://scs.msu.edu/sa/consult/>
2. You must submit your paper with an abstract:

3. Superscript your references in-text in sequential order
 - a. Make sure the order of your in-text references matches your numbered reference list!
 - b. See our Standards for Reference Citation guide:
<https://scs.msu.edu/smrj/pdf/SMRJ%20Standards%20for%20References.pdf>
4. Include continuous line numbers.
5. If you have one, include a target journal with your copy editing request.
6. Copy editor will look over your manuscript two times after your copy edit request, so make sure it's a finished draft!
7. Include information about your IRB approval in your manuscript
 - a. Unless you have a case study/ case report, you must obtain IRB approval.
8. Paragraphs should have a maximum of 6 sentences.
9. Avoid slang/ informal language.
10. Acknowledge project limitations in its own section.
11. Always go back to your cited studies in your "Discussion" section
 - a. How do your findings relate or contradict earlier studies?
12. Spell out any abbreviated term the first time you use it.
13. Use clear and specific language for a general readership that does not overstate findings.
14. No plagiarism from any of your or other individual's earlier works.
 - a. Include any information concerning other publications from the same project.
